### SAVE THE DATES – ADVENT BIBLE STUDY

We will meet Thursday's – Nov. 18, Dec 2, 9 and 16 – from 7pm to 830pm.

Have you ever felt that when Christmas comes around that you're just not ready? Of all the liturgical seasons of the year, Advent is certainly the most stressful, and it may be the most confusing. As Catholics we seem to have a good grasp of Christmas, Lent and Easter. But what is the deeper meaning of Advent? And how can understanding this season help us better prepare for Christmas?

Please join me for a four week series as we learn about:

The Second Advent at the End of Time: What will happen at the end of time? And why does Advent begin with end-time prophecies about the Tribulation, the Final Judgement, and the second coming of Christ?

Jewish Prophecies of the Messiah: How do Catholics know that Jesus is truly the Messiah and not just one more religious leader? What are the most important Old Testament prophecies about the first "coming" of the Messiah?

John the Baptist: Who was the mysterious figure of John the Baptist? Why did Jesus call him the greatest of all the prophets, and why does the Church spend so much time on him during the Advent season?

The Jesse Tree: What are the Jewish roots of the Advent custom of the Jesse Tree? Where does this tree come from in the Jewish Bible?

The City of Bethlehem: Ancient Jewish prophecy foretold that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem. Why? What is the Hebrew meaning of Jesus' Nativity?

The Virgin Birth: Why was Jesus born of a Virgin? How did the Blessed Virgin and St. Joseph react to the news? What Catholics say to those who are skeptical about this great miracle? Who are we? We are women who embrace the Gospel and who continue to take action to make the world a better place!

Catholic Daughters of the Americas (CDA) provides its members with programs to help focus on the needs of the church and society, at the local, state and national levels. Our state structure consists of an elected State Board of officers: State Regent, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice State Regent, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice State Regent, State Secretary and State Treasurer.

At the local level, our elected Court officers are Regent, Vice Regent, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary and Treasurer. Local courts are required to hold nine (9) meetings a year beginning in September. The times and places for these local meetings are decided and voted on by each individual court.

The CDA was founded in 1903, and today there are over 80,000 dues paying members in 1,250 courts in 45 states across the United States and Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands. With guidance from our patron the Blessed Mother, we are a deeply spiritual group of Catholic women eighteen (18) years and older who desire to share our faith, love of God and the desire to help those in need. Young women between the ages of eight (8) and eighteen (18) can join our Junior CDA. Young college women are encouraged to become members of Campus Courts.
